Privacy Policy

Introduction

Investmachine, Inc. ("Investmachine" or "We") respects your privacy and are committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy. This policy describes:

The types of information we may collect or that you may provide when you: use our websites (<https://www.onepass.xyz>) (each a "Site", and collectively, the "Sites"); and

Our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This policy applies only to information we collect on the Services and in email, text, and other electronic communications sent through or in connection with the Services.

This policy DOES NOT apply to information that:

We collect offline, or

You provide to or is collected by any third party (see Third-Party Information Collection).

The Services contain links to third-party websites, products or services. The Services may also display content from third parties. Information collected by third parties is governed by those third parties privacy policies. We encourage you to read these before providing information on or through them. Please read this policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, do not download, register with, or use the Services. By downloading, registering with, or using this Services you agree to this privacy policy. This policy may change from time to time (see Changes to Our Privacy Policy). Your continued use of these Services after we revise this

policy means you accept those changes, so please check the policy periodically for updates.

Children Under the Age of 16

The Services are not intended for children under 16 years of age, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 16. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from a child under 16 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information. Information We Collect and How We Collect It

We collect several types of information from and about users of our Services, from two sources:

You, either directly when provide it to us or automatically when you use our Services; and
Third parties.

- **Information You Provide to Us Directly**

When using our Services, you may provide us with certain types of information which may include, information:

By which you may be personally identified, such as name, postal address, email address, or any other identifier by which you may be contacted online or offline ("personal information").

About your internet connection, web browser, the equipment you use to access our Services, and usage details.

This information includes:

Information you provide us when you create an account.

Information and content that you provide us when you fill out the Contact form on our Site.

Information and content that you provide us when you register for or upload comments on our forum.

Information and content that you provide when you leave a reply on our blog.

Information you provide when you subscribe to our email list.

Information and content that you provide us when you interact with us on one

of our social accounts (at present we have accounts on Twitch, Instagram, Facebook, YouTube, Twitter, or Discord).

Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses and phone numbers), if you contact us.

Details of transactions you carry out through the Services and of the fulfillment of your orders. You may be required to provide financial information before placing an order through the Services.

- **Information Collected Automatically When You Use Our Services**

When you download, access, and use the Services it may use technology to automatically collect:

Usage Details. When you access and use the Services, we may automatically collect certain details of your access to and use of the Services including traffic data, logs, communication data, and the resources that you access and use on or through the Services

Device or Computer Information. We may collect information about your IP address.

If you do not want us to collect this information do not use the Services.

Do Not Track Disclosure

The Services do not support "Do Not Track" browser settings and do not currently participate in any "Do Not Track" framework that would enable us to respond to Do Not Track signals.

Information Collection Technologies: Cookie Policy

Like most websites, we use small data files that are saved on the user's computer, tablet, mobile phone, or another mobile device (collectively referred to as "device") to record certain data each time a user logs in or interacts with our websites, services, apps, messaging systems and tools.

The technologies we use for automatic information collection may include:

Cookies: small text files (typically made up of letters and numbers) that are stored in the memory of your browser or device when you visit a website or view a message. Cookies allow a website to recognize a particular device or browser.

Web Beacons: small images, also known as "pixel tags" or "clear GIFs", which we may include in our websites, services, apps, messages, and tools. Generally, they work with cookies to identify our users and their activities.

Similar Technologies: technologies that store data in the browser or device using objects shared or stored locally, such as flash cookies, HTML 5 cookies and other software methods for web applications. These technologies work in all browsers. In some cases, the use of local storage cannot be fully handled by the browser, but needs to be managed with special tools. We do not use these technologies to store information useful for creating targeted advertising on our or other websites. The terms "cookie" and "similar technologies" can be used interchangeably in this policy with reference to all technologies used to store data in the browser or the user's device or to the technologies that collect data or allow the user to be identified as described above.

These technologies can be broken down into the following categories based on what they do:

Strictly Necessary Cookies: These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be turned off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you that amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in, or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the site will not then work. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.

Performance Cookies: These are also sometimes called Analytics Cookies. They allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. They help us to know which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around the site. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. If you do not allow these cookies we will not know when you have visited our site and will not be able to monitor its performance.

Functional Cookies: These cookies enable the website to provide enhanced functionality and personalization. They may be set by us or by third party providers whose services we have added to our Services. If you do not allow these cookies then some or all of these services may not function properly.

Targeting Cookies: These cookies are also called Marketing Cookies. They may be set through our site by our advertising partners. They may be used by those companies to build a profile of your interests and show you relevant ads on other sites. They do not store directly personal information but are based on uniquely identifying your browser and internet device. If you do not allow these cookies, you will experience less targeted advertising.

Social Media Cookies: These cookies are set by a range of social media services that we have added to the site to enable you to share our content with your friends and networks. They are capable of tracking your browser across other sites and building up a profile of your interests. This may impact the content and messages you see on other websites you visit. If you do not allow these cookies you may not be able to use or see these sharing tools.

Controlling Cookies

You can control the cookies deployed through the Services by using your browser settings. Find the settings panel of the browser that you are using to access the Services and select the cookie preferences that you feel most comfortable with. Please note, however, that disabling certain cookies may have an effect on how the Services function.

How We Use Your Information

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any personal information, to:

Provide you with the Services, and any other information, products or services that you specifically request from us.

Improve and optimize our Services and our users' experiences.

Fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it.

Carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including for billing and collection.

To comply with our legal obligations.

Notify you when Services updates are available, and of changes to any products or services we offer or provide through it.

Communicate with you about our offerings.

To provide you with customer support.

Prevent or investigate user complaints, possible fraud or other violations of our Terms of Use or for other security purposes.

The usage information we collect helps us to improve our Services and to deliver a better and more personalized experience by enabling us to:

Estimate our audience size, demographics and usage patterns.

Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize our Services according to your individual interests.

Recognize you when you use the Services

Prevent fraud and illegal behavior by detecting behavior patterns that indicate such activity.

If you've subscribed to our email list, we may also use your information to contact you about Company news and new games or services that may be of interest to you. You can unsubscribe from these emails at any time. (For more information, see Your Rights and Choices below.)

Disclosure of Your Information

We may disclose aggregated information about our users, and information that does not identify any individual or device without restriction.

In addition, we may disclose personal information that we collect, or you provide:

To the Creator, through whose onepass you provide the personal information, so that they may provide you with the services or goods that you request through their onepass. For example if you support a Creator through their onepass, we will share with them the information necessary for them to thank you. If you purchase from a Creator through their onepass we will provide them the information necessary to ship and track purchases, and provide you with information about their activities and other offerings. Using a Creator's onepass you consent to our sharing of the information you provide with them. We provide education and resources to our Creators on the appropriate treatment of your personal data and require all Creators using a to agree to the terms of our

onepass Creator Data Processing Agreement to ensure the appropriate, lawful treatment of your personal information.

To our subsidiaries and affiliates.

To contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our business.

To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of Investmachine, Inc.'s assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by onepass, Inc. about our Services users is among the assets transferred.

To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.

For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.

With your consent.

To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.

To enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including our Terms of Service.

If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Investmachine, Inc., our customers or others.

Where, How, and How Long Do We Store Your Information

OnePass is based in the United States. As such the information you provide is collected and stored in the U.S. We store your information securely using third-party vendors and hosting partners who implement industry-standard security measures. Using the Services, you authorize us to transfer, store and process your information in the United States and any other country where we operate.

We keep your information only for the length of time necessary to fulfill the purposes for which the information was collected. For example, if you have an account with us, we will retain the personal information associated with your account for the lifetime of your account. If applicable laws require us to store your information for a longer

period, then we will keep your information for the period of time required by law. When it is no longer necessary or required for us to retain your data, we will delete it.

Your Rights and Choices

Data Protection Rights

The laws of the European Economic Area and other territories provide their residents with certain data protection rights. If you are a resident of the European Economic Area, these are your rights:

The right to access - You have the right to request Investmachine provide you with copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification - You have the right to request that Investmachine correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Investmachine to complete a statement you believe is incomplete.

The right to be forgotten - You have the right to request that Investmachine erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing - You have the right to request that Investmachine restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing - You have the right to object to Investmachine's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability - You have the right to request that Investmachine transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

Additional Data Choices

We strive to provide you with choices regarding the personal information you provide to us. This section describes mechanisms we provide for you to control certain uses and disclosures of over your information.
